the Lord has Blest me with in the world I desire to Give and Bequeath as follows Buried

Item first of all I desire that my Body be decently according to Christ. Rules and Secondly that all my just and lawful debts be Justly Paid out of my Estate.

Item I desire my Beloved wife Rachel Pearson to have a comfortable and Sufficent Mantanance out of my Estate during her Natural Life and live on the lands I now posses during her life also I leave to my beloved wife a Negro woman Hamer Hanner and after her death I Give and Bequeath the said Negro woman Hanna to my beloved daughter Rachel Pearson with all increase weather Boys or Girls-----

Item I Give <sup>son</sup> and Bequeath to my beloved Willm H. Pearson a Certain tract of Land Containing Eighty two Acres which is called the lower end of a big plantation & all the Property he now Possfefs

Item I Give and Bequeath to my beloved Son Thomas Pearson a tract or Parcel of land of Eighty two Acres being y upper part of y big Plantation y<sup>e</sup> road Joining Henry Hodges land & One Creature & One Negro boy names James.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my beloved daughter Peggy <sup>B</sup> Pritton one Negro Girl named Patt one Cow and Calf 2 sows & pigg

Item I Giye and Bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Polly Pearson a plantation a Tract of Land where Chessey Handly now lives

named Mary.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my beloved son Joshua J. Pearson the Tract of Land whereon I now live Being the Lower part of half of a tract of land of Three Hundred acres Granted to Haskin Newberry also one hundred acres Granted to my Self lying on the sd. East Side of the foure mentioned land between land of Barron Poelintz Wm. Coxes and Said before mentioned Land also one Negro boy named Jonah

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Samuel Pearson One Tract of Land of one hundred and Fifty acres more or less Being the upper half of Sadi Tract, beforesaid granted to Haskin Newberry where my old house and Orchard Stands also a Small Parcel of about fifty acres Joining the Lower Corner of Said Land and Henry Hodges land and a deep Whold in y<sup>e</sup> 3 creeks Cawled Lideas Hole Including y<sup>e</sup> 3 Creeks and a small peace over the Said Creeks Calld Flory<sup>e</sup> Hill where Daniel Evans keeps school and adjoining land I Sold to John Askew Granted to John Hodges also one Negro boy named Dempsey

Item all the my Property Containing of Land or Negro Not before mentioned Cattle Hogs Sheep Horses Plantation Tools and all y<sup>e</sup> property of what Ever kind I dye Pofsed of to be Evenly Divided Between Peggy Britton Polly Pearson Joshua Pearson & Samuel Pearson and my youngest Daughter Rachel Pearson Also I nominate and appoint my Beloved Wife Rachel Pearson and my beloved friend calld Thomas Evans and Ipse Vining to be my Executors to this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills hithertofore made by me in witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand and Seal this Twenty sixth Day December in y<sup>e</sup> year of our Lord 1799
