Unto my well beloved Arch.^d one Dollar also to my well beloved daughter Flora and her Husband Hugh McGill two Dollars also to my loving son Duncan one hundred dollars all the reast of my Residue of my money goods chattles Estate and effects of what nature or kind soever Including all my Land Debts and Demands I give and Bequeath to be Equally divided Between my beloved son ^{Daniel} David my beloved son Neill and I do hereby nominate and appoint the s^d Daniel Thompson & Neill Thompson Esq. of this my last will and testament Revoking and making void all and every other will or wills at any time heretofore made by me and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 29th day of June and in the year of our Lord 1808
