

Beit known to all whom it may concern, That I Sarah Wright of the District of Marlborough in the State of South Carolina being old and infirm in body, but of sound mind, do make and ordain this as my last will & Testament, With respect to such worldly goods as it hath pleased God to ble's me with that is to say.-----

First, I give and bequeath unto my son William, all my real estate, together with five Negroes and their increase, Viz-Cato Stephen, Fanny, Alick and Hannah to him his heirs and assigns forever and also the whole of my stock of black cattle except three cows and calves-----But the before mentioned devise is on condition that my said Son William do pay to my six Grand daughters, Sarah Burch and Rebecca Burch, Sarah Wright, Ann Wright and Rebecca Wright, and Mary Lamb, the sum of one hundred dollars each and to my grand daughter Sarah Ann Lide, the sum of Four hundred and seventy five dollars which said sum of four hundred and seventy fivedollars I request and desire my said son William to the purchase of a suitable negro woman as early after my decease as practicable which Negroe woman so purchased with her increase shall be the unalienable right and property of the said Sarah Ann Lide--- but in case my said granddaughter Sarah Ann Lide shall die without Issue then it is my will that the said negro woman and her increase beequally divided between my grand sons, Robert Lide and Thomas Lide.---

Secondly, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca the number of four Negroes (to wit) Grace, Hablot, Milla and Juda and their increase together with three cows and calves and one feather bed and furniture.-----

Thirdly, I leave my son William and Joseph as Executors to this my last will and Testament, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighth day of November Anno Domini, Eighteen hundred and Sixteen.
