Deasee , I give and bequeath the aforesaid negroes and the
Increase of the female (if any) to hur Children to be Equally
Devided amoungst them-----

Item I Lend to my Daughter Nancy Thomas for the term of her
life one negor man named Prince and one negro woman named
Rachel and her Increase and at her Decease I give and Bequeath
the aforesaid negroes & their Increase, to her Children to be
Equally Devided amoungst them-----

Item I Lend to my Daughter Elizabeth Thomas for the term of
her Life one Negroe man names C harlee and one negroe woman
and her Increase, (the Last mentioned negroe womans name is
Fillis) and at her Decease I give and Bequeathe the aforesaid
negroes with the Increase to her Children to be Equally Devided
amoungst them----

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughters Nancy Thomas and
Elizabeth Thomas (after mene & their mothers Death) one negroe
woman named Luttey-----

Item - I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Thomas (after mine and my
wife's Deathe) all my personally property that is not mentioned

Item - I give and Bequeathe to my gran Son Joseph Pledger Thomas- after mine and my wife's deathe all my Lands that Shalh be in my pofseifson at my Deathe-----turn over-----
And Lastly I do hereby Constitute make and ordain my Beloved Wife Susanah Bingham Executrix and my Beloved Soninlaw Wathan Thomas and John Thomas Executors of this my Last Will and Testament, ~~I do hereby~~ utterly Disallow Revoke, and Disannul all and Every other former Testaments will and Bequests, by me in aney way before this time names to be my Last Will and Testament, in Witnefs Whereof I have Heave unto Set my hand and Seal the Day and year first above written--Signed Sealed
