dated in the district aforesaid, the thirtieth day of October, in the
year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Two, and
in the Twenty first year of the Independence of America.

Whereas administration of all and singular the goods and
chattels, rights and credits of the said Thomas Conner deceased,
was lately committed by the said Joel Winfield unto the said
James Conner.

The Condition of the above obligation is such

that if the above bound Thomas Conner administrator of the goods, chattels and credits of Thomas Conner deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have, or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said James Conner or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same so made, do exhibit into the said court of Ordinary when he shall be thereunto Required, and such goods, chattels and credits do well and truly administer according to Law, and do make a just and true account of his actings and doings therein when Required by the said court, and all the rest of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found Remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first allowed by the said court, shall deliver and pay unto such persons Respectively, as are intitled to the same by Law, and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and Testament was made by the said deceased, and the same be proven in court, and the Executors obtain a certificate of the probate thereof, and the said James Conner do in such case, if Required, render and deliver up the said letters of administration then this obligation to be void or Else to remain in full force.
