I thimas Huckaby Of the State of South Carolina & district of Marlborough being well Stricken in years but of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last Will & Testament in manner & form follwoing that is to Say.

Unto the children of my former wife Batty namely Polly Barkow, Betsy Woodle, Nancy Rachels, Willis Huckaby, Wilson Huckaby & James Huckaby I give and bequeath my plantation known by the name of Darling Jones's containing sixty seven acres & to their heirs and assigns forever to be equally divided among them at my death-----

Unto my two youngest sons the children of my present Wife Nancy namely Thomas Huckaby & Allan Huckaby & their heirs & assigns forever I give and bequeath all & singular the remaining & other property of which I may die Seized & possessed Subject to the maintenance & support of their Mother Nancy during her life to be equally divided between Said Thomas & Allan at the day of their mother's death Should she Survive me-----

I nominate constitute and appoint my truly & worthy friends William Bristow & George Bristow Esq.^{rs} my sole and lawful Executors to carry this my last Will & Testament into full and complete effect-----And I do furthermore revoke disannul & make void all Wills legacies & bequests heretofore by me made pronouncing & declaring this to be my last Will & Testament as expressed in the preceeding page----
