First. I will and desire that all Just debts that I may owe at the time of my death may be fully paid & discharged.

I lend unto my beloved Wife Catherine Quick the use of all my Estate Real & Personal during the term of her natural Life.

I Give & Bequeath unto my Son Thomas Quick Jr. at the death of my loving Wife one Half of a tract of Land lying below Crooked Creek being my part of a tract owned Jointly by Aquilla Quick and myself. Containing about Two Hundred Acres also about Ten Acres of a Tract granted to myself for Ninety nine acres being all of the Said tract Lying on the North West Side of the public road leading by Brights Mill & Duncans McLarrens.

Also a negro man named Dick with a Sett of Blacksmiths tools also one half of the Stock of Cattle at John Brig-
gans, to him and his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Son James Quick at the death of my beloved wife all Those two tracts of Land known by the Goodon & Perquosin tracts adjoining Lands of Benja Williams & William G. Vernon Supposed to Contain Three hundred Acres also two Negroe Slaves. Amelia & her son Moses with the Increase of Amelia one bed and Furniture and one half of the Stock of Cattle at my daughter Patty Driggers to him & his heirs forever.

I lend unto my daughter Rachel Grooms at the death of my loving

being the upper part of the tract and supposed to Con-
tain two hundred & fifty Acres: four Cows & Calves and
One Bed & Furniture during her Natural life and at her
death I give and Bequeath the Same to her children to be

al life after the Death of my Loving wife and one half of
a tract of Land Situate above George Quick Sen. Supposed
to Contain Two hundred & fifty Acres being the lower half
also one Negro woman named Nan Known by deep river Nan with
her future Increase. And one bed & Furniture and at her
death I give & Bequeath the Same to her Children bearing
the Name of Rollo by Her Present Husband to be equally di-
vided among them.

I lend unto my daughter Jane Ballard at the death of my lov-
ing wife a tract of Land Situate below Crooked Creek and bel-
ow the Big Branch that Runs by Brigmans Place adjoining lands
of Thomas Huckabee. Younger Newton & down to Liles Skipper
Line to the Big Branch Also one Negro Woman Foreby with her
Increase and one half of the Stock of Cattle at John Brig-
mans and at her death I give & Bequeath the Same to her Child-
ren to be divided Equally Among them.

Named Chezzy with her Increase, One negro boy Named Daniel,
One Bed and Furniture one fifth part of all my Household and
Kitchen Furniture of every description except the bed & furni-
ture otherwise disposed of and one sixth part of all my Stock
of Horses Cattle Hogs Sheep Poultry Plantations tools & Farm-

ing Utensils of every description at the Homeplace except four Cows & Calves, lent to my daughter Rachel Grooms to her & her heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my daughter Susannah Quick at the death of my beloved Wife one fifth part of the Land whereon I now live Called the Home tract supposed to contain upward of Six hundred acres. Granted to Joseph Johnson. Also two negro slaves (viz) one Negro man named Allen & One Negro woman named Sally with the Increase of Sally one bed & Furniture one fifth one fifth of all my Household & Kitchen furniture of every description except the beds & Furniture otherwise disposed of and one sixth part of all my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, Poultry, Plantation tools & farming Utensils of every description at the Homeplace except four Cows & Calves lent to my daughter Rachel Grooms To her & her heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Louise Quick at the death of my Loving Wife one fifth Part of all the land whereon I now live Calld the Home place Supposed to Contain upwards of Six Hundred Acres. Also one Negro Woman named Sylvia & her three children Janey, Amelia and Minta with their future increase one bed and Furniture one fifth part of all my household & Kitchen furniture of every description except the beds and furniture otherwise disposed of and one ^{sixth} ~~sixth~~ part of all my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs, Sheep Poultry plantation tools and farming utensils of every description at the Home Place except four Cows & Calves lent to my daughter Rachel Grooms ... to her & her increase forever.

I Give and bequeath to my Grandson David Quick at the death of my Loving Wife One fifth part of all the Land whereon I now live Called the Homeplace Supposed to Contain upwards of Six hundred acres Granted to Joseph Johnson also two Negroe Boys (viz) one Boy Named Averet, & one other Boy Named Peter,

one bed and furniture, one fifth part of all my household & kitchen furniture of every description except the beds & furniture otherwise disposed of and one sixth part of all Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, Poultry Plantation tools and farming Utensils of every discription at the Home Place except four Cows & Calves lent to my daughter Rachel Grooms to her & his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Jane Quick at the death of my beloved wife one fifth part of all the lands whereon I now live called the Homeplace. Granted to Joseph Solomon supposed to contain upwards of Six hundred acres also two Negro Slaves (viz) one woman known by the Name of old Nancy the other her daughter known by Name Young Nancy with their future increase one bed & furniture. One fifth part of all my Household & kitchen furniture of every description except the Beds and furniture otherwise disposed of.

And one Sixth part of all my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, Poultry Plantation tools and farming Utensils of every description at the Home place except four Cows & Calves lent to my daughter Rachel Grooms.. to her & her heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Temperence Brigmton at the deatt of my beloved wife the half of a tract of Land Situate in the fork of Crooked & the Light wood Knot Creek Supposed to Contain Two hundred & fifty acres being one half of a tract of Land I purchased of Aquilla Quick & that part Lying on Crooked Creek Also two Negro slaves one Named Patt & the other named Rose with their Increase and the Stock of Cattle at Joshua Brigmtons to her & her ~~heirs~~ heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Grandson Drury Skipper at the death of my loving wife all my land Lying on the lower Side of Crooked Creek on the S^o East side of Thomas Quicks Jr.

Land & above the Big Branch on both sides of the Public Road leading by Brights Mill and Duncan McLaxxens except the lot laid off for the Meeting House also two Negroes Boys named Bill & Jim Bed and Furniture and one Sixth part of all my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs Sheep Poultry Plantation tools and farming Utensils of every description at the Home place except four Cows & Calves lent to my daughter Rachel Griggs to him & his heirs forever. I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Patter Briggers one half of my Stock of Cattle at her house to her & her heirs forever and the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to be paid to her by my Executors when my Will Shall be proven & my Exors. Shall have been Qualifid. Provided my Said Daughter Shall be living at the time of my death but not otherwise. I Give & Bequeath unto my Three Grand Children Named Lylla Quick, Alice Quick & Anquish Quick Two hundred Dollars to be paid to them by my Executors when they shall arrive at Lawful age or Marry in equal proportion to them & their Heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my Grand Children Arthur Skipper and Nancy Skipper one half of a tract of Land Situate in the fork of Crooked Creek & Lightwood Knot Creeks that half lying on the lightwood Knot lying part of a tract of Land I purchased from Aquilla Quick deceased Supposed to Contain Two hundred & Fifty Acres to be divided between them Share & Share alike at the death of my Loving Wife or when they shall arrive at Lawful age or Shall Marry to them & their Heirs forever.
