In the name of God Amen.

I Thomas Turner of the State of South Carolina and District of Marlborough, being weak in body, but of sound and perfect mind and memory blefsted be God, for the same, do make this My last Will and Testament, in manner and form following (viz) the whole of my real Estate land and negroes Horses and Cattle Hogs and sheep, plantation tools household and kitchen furniture and all other utensils thereunto belonging to be equally divided between my sons and Daughters, namely James, Aaron, Jame, Thomas, Moses, John, Mark, Mary, I desire that Nathaniel Gibson, John Gibson and Samuel Goodwin should act Executors to this my last will and Testament, and hereby revokeing all former Wills by me made in Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this tewntieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-two.
