All the rest residue and remainder of my estate both real and personal I give devise and bequeath unto My five affectionate and dutiful children viz Samuel I. Brown, James C. Brown, William H. Brown, Eliza Ann Brown and Charles G. Brown to be equally distributed amongst them to have and to hold to them their heirs and assigns forever, And it is my will and desire that each of my children shall receive his part to himself whenever he arrives to the age of twenty one and not before except my daughter Eliza who shall receive her share whenever she marries or when she attains to the age of twenty one. And it is farther my will and desire that My Wife and Children shall severally Continue to enjoy the use benefit and interest of my dwelling house and lot so long as it shall be found conducive to their interest. And I do nominate constitute and appoint Julius Poellnits John Brown, James Brown and ^{Jerimiah} ~~Samuel~~ H. Brown and my son Samuel I. Brown executors of this my last will and testament In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal the twenty fifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four.
