A. GILBAL.

State of South Carolina } To Wit
Newberry District.

I A. Gilbal, of the District and State aforesaid, do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament.

First, My will and desire is that all my just debts be paid.

Secondly, It is my will and desire that all my property, both real and personal, be sold by my executors, here in after named, except my negre woman Jane, her son Aaron and her daughter Eliza.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto my executors, here in after named, my negre woman Jane her son Aaron and her daughter Eliza, with a positive injunction and dying request, that they have them removed to the State of Ohio, in the neighbourhood of Troy, where Katharine a girl whom I have already manumitted, resides.

Fourthly, I give and bequeath unto my executors, here in after named, all the rest and residue of my estate, which I earnestly request and enjoin upon them, to apply so much there of as may be sufficient, for the removal above directed, of the negrees named in the clause above, and that when removed they give Jane one hundred dollars, for their support and maintenance for one year, and that they put the balance out at interest, and send annually the interest arising thereon, to Ohio, to be equally divided between and amongst Katharine, (whom I have already sent to Ohio) Aaron and Eliza, or if they or either of them be dead leaving children, those children to have the share which their parent if alive would have received, if without children,

Secondly, It is my will and desire that all my property, both real and personal, be sold by my executors, here in after named, except my negro woman Jane, her son Aaron and her daughter Eliza.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto my executors, here in after named, my negro woman Jane her son Aaron and her daughter Eliza, with a positive injunction and dying request, that they have them removed to the State of Ohio, in the neighbourhood of Troy, where Katharine a girl whom I have already manumitted, resides.

Fourthly, I give and bequeath unto my executors, here in after named, all the rest and residue of my estate, which I earnestly request and enjoin upon them, to apply so much there of as may be sufficient, for the removal above directed, of the negroes named in the clause above, and that when removed they give Jane one hundred dollars, for their support and maintenance for one year, and that they put the balance out at interest, and send annually the interest arising thereon, to Ohio, to be equally divided between and amongst Katharine, (whom I have already sent to Ohio) Aaron and Eliza, or if they or either of them be dead leaving children, these children to have the share which their parent if alive would have received, if without children, between and amongst the survivor or survivors.

Lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint Thomas B. Rutherford, John Belton O'Moall and L. J. Jones, executors of this my last will and testament, in testimony where of I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal, this twenty second day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one.
