Newberry District | I Andrew Suber of the State and District  
aforesaid being weak in body but of sound and disposing mind  
and knowing the certainty of death and the uncertainty of life  
have made this my last will and Testament and dispose of my pro-  
perty in the following manner

Clause 1<sup>st</sup>

I will that my property to be sold at publick auction on such  
a credit as my Executor may think proper

Clause 2<sup>d</sup>

I will in the next place that all my Just debts be paid

Clause 3

I wish in the next place for my grave yard at the Enaree church  
burying ground to be enclosed with paleings posts and rail-  
lings of the best materials to be put up in a substantial manner  
and painted in good order and the graves of my self and wife and  
children and also the graves of Thomas M. Jenkins and Mary Eliz-  
abeth Sligh to be enclosed by walls of hem or dressed stone and  
also a head stone of Marble of sufficient size to engrave the  
names, time of birth death &c of all of the above named Dece of  
my family

Clause 4<sup>th</sup>

I will further that my Mother have \$16.00 of my Estate for the  
purpose of procuring head & foot stones for her grave

Clause 5

I do for the respect that I have for and the confidence that I

repose in my friend David Sligh appoint my Executor and autho-

Clause 2d

I will in the next place that all my Just debts be paid

Clause 3

I wish in the next place for my grave yard at the Knores church burrying ground to be enclosed with paleings postes and railings of the best materials to be put up in a substantial manner and painted in good order and the Graves of my self and wife and children and also the Graves of Thomas M. Jenkins and Mary Elizabeth Sligh to be enclosed by walls of brown or dressed stone and ~~also~~ a head stone of Marble of sufficient size to engrave the names, time of birth death &c of all of the above named Decease of my family

Clause 4th

I will further that my Mother have \$16.00 of my Estate for the purpose of procuring head & foot stones for her grave

Clause 5

I do for the respect that I have for and the confidence that I repose in my friend David Sligh appoint <sup>him</sup> my Executor and authorise and empower him to put in full force this my last Will and Testament and give to him Fifteen Dollars over and above his Lawful commissions on my Estate for such extra trouble as he may be at in the execution of the same

Clause 6

I further will that if there should be any portion of the proceeds of my Estate left after the above named expences to paid I wish it to equally divided between my Mother Elizabeth Hill, my Brothers and sisters (half Brothers included) and William Malone and his

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lawful Grand children,

the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty three
