

State of S. C. Corroborate: In the name of god Amen I James Chandler
 of Newberry District - being well in body but a perfect mind and
 Memory knowing that it is appointed for all men to die and be
 living in a Resurrection after Death to make this my last will and
 Testament, first I give my body to God to be decently buried at
 the Discretion of my Executors here in after I named - My debt to God
 that give it me and for my worldly goods as it hath pleased
 God to bestow on me. I dispose of in the following manner and
 form first of all I give unto my well beloved wife Susanah
 Chandler Dowsing her natural life or widow hood or pleasure
 all my tract of Land that I now live on and at her death or pleas-
 ure to be sold and the money arising by the sale to be equally
 divided between my Children. I give unto my well beloved son
 Jesse Chandler twenty six dollars to be paid out of my personal estate
 within two years from this date. Then I give and bequeath unto
 my daughter Mary Ann Chandler one good feather bed and furniture
 and one good Cow and Calf. Then I give and bequeath unto
 my daughter Rebecca Derby one good feather bed and furniture
 and one Cow and Calf. And after paying all my just debts
 and discharges before mentioned my will is that my well
 beloved wife Susanah shall have the whole of my estate not
 bequeathed writing her natural life or widow hood. With this pro-
 viso that Mary Elizabeth my sister in Law be lawfully maintained
 and clothed with the assistance of her Industry out of the Estate
 after my Death and the Death of my wife Susanah Chandler at
 the full expense of my Children or heirs, ^{and then my Estate to be sold and given}
^{to my son William Chandler} My son in Law Noah Bonds and
 my son William Chandler to be my whole and sole Executors of
 this my last will and testament. Ratifying and allowing this
 to be my last will and testament. Revoking all others and
 disallowing any other will or testament or writing what ever
 But Ratifying and Confirming this to be my last will and testament
 written on one paper of paper this second day of March 1808.
