said do declare the following to be my last will and Testament

Clause 1 It is my desier that my Just debts be paid out of the proceeds of the sale of my general Estate and also my funeral expences

Clause 2nd. It is my will that my sons Enoch and George A. Suber have the two choice beds in my house also the two choice bedtods and each bed to be furnished with the usual cloathing etc., belonging to Beds generally - also to each of the above named Enoch and G. A. Suber ~~one~~ ^{son} of my choice cows and calves one to my son Enoch Suber my Bay mare Montgomery and to my / G. A. Suber my Bay coal mill

Clause 3rd It is my will that if I should die in the course of this year that my sons Enoch and G. A. Suber have all of the exec and proceeds of the same that is at this time on the plantation to be equally divided betwene them

Clause 4 It is my will that all my Estate both real and personal (excep the above named) be sold as soon after my death and upon such terms and credits as my Executors may think best and the proceeds of the same to be equally divided among my legal heirs

Clause 5th I appoint my son Enoch Suber and William Hatton my executors with full power and authority to carry ~~it~~/~~it~~/ out my wishes as expressed in this my last will and Testament given under my hand and signed sealed and deliverd in the presance of the subscribing witnessess this Fifth day of october 1845 and in the twenty first year of the Sovereignty and Indpendence of the United

Clause 2nd It is my will that my sons Enoch and George A.
Shober have the two choice beds in my house also, the two choice
bedsteads and each bed to be furnished with the usual cloathing
etc., belonging to Beds generally - also to each of the above
named Enoch and G. A. Suber one of my choice cows and calves
one to my son Enoch Suber my Bay mare Montgomery and to my /
son

John Suber my Bay coal & hill

Clause 3rd It is my will that if I should die in the course
of this year that my sons Enoch and G. A. Suber have all of the
crop and proceeds of the same that is at this time on the plan-
tation to be equally divided betwene them

Clause 4 It is my will that all my Estate both real and
personal (except the above named) be sold as soon after my death
and upon such terms and credits as my Executors may think best
and the proceeds of the same to be equally divided among my legal
heirs

Clause 5th I appoint my son Enoch Suber and William Hatton my
executors with full power and authority to carry into effect out my
wishes as expressed in this my last will and Testament given un-
der my hand and signed sealed and deliverd in the presence of the
subscribing witnesses this Fifth day of October 1846 and in the
Twenty first year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United
States of America
