Item; I Give unto my Well Beloved Daughter Margeret Cox One Black Mair Named Ring Tail and Two Cows and Calves -----

Item; I Give unto my Well Beloved Daughter Sarah Cox a Horse Colt Named Rain Waters and 2 Cows and Calves -----

Item; I Leave unto my Loving wife Ann Cox One Sorrel Mair & Yearling horse Colt and the third of all the Cattle and her Bedding and all the household Goods which she formerly Claimed as her property -----

Item; I Give unto my Well Beloved Son John Cox one Horse Saddle and Bridle -----

Item; As a Memorandum I leave unto my Well Beloved Daughtere Elisabeth Stuard and Mary Stuard five pounds Each in old Currency to be paid by my 3 Sons which Enjoys & heirs my Land and after my Just Debts are all paid and my body Buried in a Decent and Christian Like manner the Rest of my Estate Goods & Chattles I Leave to my Two Sons William Cox and George Cox whome I shall after Name, And I do hereby Constitute, Appoint, Name & Ordain William Cox, and George Cox my two Sons before Named to be the Executors of this my Last Will Disannulling and making Void all former Wills whatsoever Confirming this No Other to be my Last and Testament ---
