

Ninety six Dist. 1 In the Name of God Amen, the Seventeenth day of October One Thousand Seven hundred & Seventy Six I Daniel Deawald of the fork between Broad & Saludy Rivers in the District and Province aforesaid am Very Sick and weak in body but of Perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God for the Same, and Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and Knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to Die do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament (that is to say Principally and first of all I give & Recommend my Soul into the hands of god that gave it, and for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian Like & Decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching Such Worldy Estate wherewith it hath Pleased God to Bless me in this Life, I give Devise Dispose of the same in the manner & form following That is to say -----

In the first Place my Will and Desire is that my Funeral Charges Charges and all my Lawfull debts shall first be paid out of my Estate -----

Secondly I give and bequeath unto Susana my beloved wife one Negro winch Named Hacker brand on her right brist thus A C and her Increase as long as she my Wife susana shall Live, and after her Death or Decease She the said Negro winch and her Increase to be Devided amoungst my four Daughters namely Marey and delane, Catherine, Susana & Rude to be Equall Divided also One Wagon and hind Gears, as also the thirds of all my moveables Estate and for her Live on my Plantation and Injoy the full of her Labor on the said Land as Long as She is alive, and all the Remainder part of my moveable Estate to be Equally Divided amoungst all my Children--

Thirdly I give unto my son Dan^l Two hundred & fifty acres of Land whereon the Plantation is Cleared and the buildings for his Sole Use & behoof forever -----

fourthly I Give unto my son Peter Deawald One hundred acres of

I also make and Ordain my beloved wife Susana my only & Sole Ex-
ecutor of this my Last Will and Testament & I do hereby utterly
Disallow Revok and Disannual all and every other former Testament
will and Leguices Requests & Executors by me in any Wise before
this time Named willed & bequeathed Reatifying & Confirming this
& no Other to be my Last Will & Testament
