Increase as long as she my Wife susana shall Live, and after her
Death or Decease She the said Negro winch and her Increase to be
Divided amoungst my four Daughters namely Marey ane delane, Cath-
rina, Susana & Rude to be Equall Divided also One Wagon and hinc
Gears, as also the thirde of all my moveables Estate and for her
Live on my Pjantation and Injoy the full of her Labor on the said
Land as Long as She is alive, and all the Remainder part of my
moveable Estate to be Equally Divided amoungest all my Children--
Thirdly I give unto my son Danl Two hundred & fifty acres of Land
whereon the Plantation is Cleared and the buildings for his Sole
Use & behoof forever -----
fourthly I give unto my son Peter Deawald One hundred acres of
