follows, viz.

both real and personal to have and to hold during her natural
life. I give unto her all my ~~property which~~ is not mentioned or
disposed of as hereinafter stated to be hers, her heirs
executors or assigns for ever.

second, I desire, that after the death of wife Martha, all the
lands which I now own shall belong to William Irvin Marchant,
son of Harriet Marchant, to be his and his heirs for ever.
