 all to die and after death then to Judgment I tharfore Recommend
 my body to the Earth and my soul to god who gave it and for my
 temporal estate which it hath pleased him to Bestow on me I give
 and Disposeth of in the following manner to wit my will and wish
 is that all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid out of my
 estate I give and bequeath unto my beloved sister Neomy gary all
 my wote in one hundr and sixty fore acars of land which is one
 half of said tract whare on we now live also I give unto my be-
 love siste Neomy gary all my pursonel property which I now possess
 which is one half of all the moavable property on said primoses
 consistin of hogs Cattle horses housel furnetue platation tools
 wagon and gearing one bead and all the bed Clothing that she owns
 I sutify this to be my laste wi ll and testament Disannulling all
 other wills forever ratifying and Confirming the above in witness
 whereof I have set my hand and seal this 14 Jay of Pubuary 1844
