South Carolina In the name of god amen I Elizabeth Gary Hemberry District of the state and Destrict afforesaid being in perfict mind and and memory but weak in body Calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is once appointed for all to die and after death then to Judgment I tharfore Recommend ey body to the Earth and my soul to god who gave it and for my temporal estate which it hath pleased him to Bestow on me I give and Disposeth of in the following manner to wit my will and wish is that all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid out of my estade i give and bequeath unto my beloved sister Neomy gary all my woite in ano hundry and sixty fore acars of Land which is one half of said tract where on we now Live also i give unto my belove siste Neony gary all my pursonel property which i now posess which is one half of all the moavable property on said primeses Consistin of hogs Catle horses housel furnetue platation tools vagon and gearing one bead and all the bed Clothing that she owns i sutify this to be my laste will and testament Disamulling all other wills forever ratifying and Confurming the above in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 14 day of Fubuary 1844 ligned in the presentes of us
