ENOS ELLIMAN

Enos Elliman of Newberry County in Twenty six District and State of South Carolina Being verry sick and weak of Body but of perfect mind and memory Blefised by God This Twentyfirst day of April in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred & Eighty seven do Make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner Following that is to say -----

First - of all I give unto my Loving Wife Catherine Elliman all my Lands Containing four hundred Acres During her Natural Life or Widowhood & after her Decease I give unto my two sons John & William Ellimans Each one hundred Acres of ^d Lands the plantation whereon I now Live to their only proper use forever ---

Item-- I leave two hundred Acres ~~being~~ the Remainder of my Lands to be Appraised and the Appraisement Equally Divided among the whole of my Children as and if my sons see cause they may pay off my Daughters Each their share of the appraisement and so hold the whole of the Land (Only with this Remark that my Sons is not Obliged to pay Cash but produce or Good property such as Corn Cattle or other property as they can agree and Enjoy the whole of the Land to their proper Use forever -----

Item I give unto my Daughter Elisabeth Elliman Five pounds Sterling to be paid within Twelve months after my Decease to her proper use for Ever -----

Item I give unto my Daughter Amey weeks one Feather bed and one Cow & other property all in her posfession to her proper use for Ever -----

Item I Give unto my Daughter Hannah Elliman five pounds Sterling to be paid within Twelve months after my Decease to her proper Use for Ever -----

Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Bonds one feather bed and one

Item I give unto my Daughter Amey weeks one Feather bed and one Cow & other property all in her pofsefsion to her proper use for Ever -----
Item I Give unto my Daughter Hannah Elliman five pounds Sterling to be paid within Twelve months after my Decease to her proper Use for Ever -----
Item I give unto my Daughter mary Bonds one feather bed and one Cow & Calf and other property in pofsefsion to her proper use for Ever -----
And after my Just Debts are all paid and my body Buried in a Decent and Christian Like manner the Rest of my Estate Goods and Chattles I Leave to the Discretion of my Loving wife Catherine Elliman Excepting only One mair Claimed by my son John

the Only and Sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament

former Testaments and wille, Ratifying and Confirming this and
no other to be my Last will and Testament -----
