I give unto my beloved wife Rachael the following
property viz the negro man Dennis one negro woman
- an mule, wagon & two shees Two cows & calves
four head of my cattle sixteen head of Hogs, all
such farming utensils as she may need, as much
of the Household & Kitchen Furniture as she
may select for her own use and also as much

of the crop as she may wish to have and to hold during her life and at her death to be sold by my Executor hereinafter appointed and divided as I direct in a future provision of this my last will & Testament

I wish that all my property of every kind whatsoever not enumerated and willed by the above bequests to my son George and my wife be sold after my death. the proceeds of which, together with ~~the~~ I hereby give to the children of my deceased daughter Mary Koon, my deceased daughter Sally Koon my deceased daughter Lucy Shappard (these children to take the shares their respective mother would have been entitled to had they been alive) and to my daughter

My wife Eve Koon wife of Martin Koon, and Elizabeth Kattenwagner wife of Jacob Kattenwagner share and share alike to them and their legal distributees forever -

Whereby direct that the property above devised to my wife after her death be sold and divided amongst my above mentioned distributees (Except Elizabeth Kattenwagner) & my sons John, William & George Koon to them and their legal distributees forever share and share alike

I hereby constitute my son George Feysa my Executor of this my last will and Testament
