convey all my lands in South Carolina lying on Enoree River and
both sides of Duncan Creek in the County of Newberry and such
bargains sales and conveyances made by the said Charles Crenshaw of
the said lands with the appurtenances thereunto belonging shall
be as good and valid in law to all intents and purposes as if I
was there present to sell and convey the same myself,

April 16th, 1799. Deed. David Dickson of Green County in the state of Georgia to Joseph Herndon of the State of North Carolina in the County of Wilks. Consideration £ 40 sterling. 100 acres in the County of Newberry and state of South Carolina in the fork of Broad and Saluda Rivers, it being a tract of land granted to William Dickson August 25th 1769, recorded in Auditor General Office in Book I. No 9 page 396 the 12th October 1769 and recorded in Secretaries Office in Book D.D.D. page 364, beginning as follows, Viz; at a stake North 55 West 31.62 to a white oak South 35 W. 31.62 to a stake thence S. 55 E. 31.62 to a pine thence N. 35 E. 31.62 to the beginning, (more fully described by plat annexed to original grant, duly recorded as aforesaid). Signed: David Dickson.
