George Dawkins sei^d late of Orangeburgh District Dec^d/ taken
from the oaths of William Balintine a subscribing Witnefs to
said Will and Elizabeth Beard who had the said Will in Custody
at the Death of the Testator and some time after, before said
Will was Destroyed -----

1st Solomon & Chloe two Negroes were Lent to M^{rs} Jemima Harbett
during her Natural Life and at her Death the said Negroes &
their Increase were to be equally Divided amongst all her Chil-
dren excepting a boy Jack who was to be Left to Nancy Barst ---

2^d That two Negroes to wit Moses a fellow & ~~Widow~~ ^{Mary} a woman were
lent to M^{rs} Anne Lane during her Natural Life and at her Death
the said two Negroes with their Increase were to be equally di-
vided amongst her Children -----

3^d To his Daughter Susannah Pope he Gave two Negroes to wit
Sinah & Antony to have & enjoy them and their increase forever-

4th To his Daughter Elisabeth Pope he gave two Negroes to wit

~~Spent~~ ~~them~~ & their increase forever-

5th To his Grand Daughter Ellin Hampton he Lent two Negroes to
wit Ellis & Esther to have & enjoy the said Negroes & their in-
crease during her Natural Life (The Witneses do not recollect
to whome the said Negroes wire left after her Death -----

6th To his Daughter the Widow Grigsby he Lent two Negroes Dick &
Elbzy to have and enjoy them & their increase during her Natural
Life and after her Death to be equally divided amongst her Chil-
dren -----

7th To his son George Dawkins he gave the following Negroes Viz
Jack, Nann, Doll, Lew, Little Doll, & Nancy, & their increase to
him & his Heirs forever -----

8th He gave A Negroe Boy Named Sam to his Grand son Thomas Bar-
rott -----

9th He Left a negroe Fellow call^d Peter in the following manner
That his son George Dawkins was to keep him but was to equally
