GEORGE HENRY WEARTS.

South Carolina

In the name of God Amen I George Henry Wearts of the District of Newberry in the state aforesaid being of sound and disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly goods or Estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, do make and Ordain this my last will in manner following, That is to say, First it is my will & desire that all my lawful Debts shall be paid.

2 I Give and bequeath to my wife Molly Wearts all my Plantation or Tracts of Land Containing four hundred & Twenty four acres (more or less) during her life also all my Negroes, vs,

Jack, Prissay, Wiklis, John, Tony, Rose, Billey, Anna, George, Lyda

& Jesse and their futer increas during as above stated, also one Waggon & harness, four head of horses that she make choice of, also as many of my cows hoggs and sheep as she may want to keep, as also as much of my household & kitchen furniture as she may need and also as much of the crop that may be growing on my s. plantation or remaining at the time of my Decease, as she may need for a support for the present year, all during her natural life Then at the death of my aforesaid wife It is my will and named

Desire that the above property shall be sold (that is to say), the land to be sold in three equal Tracts, and all the other property that may be remaining at the time of my wifes Decease also to be sold and Equally Divided amongst my nine Children here in after named. I give to my son John Wearts Two hundred & twenty five acres more or less, also a mare & saddle all in his possession.

I Give to my son Michael Wearts Two hundred & twenty two acres of
