I George Kinard of the State and District aforesaid being of sound and disposing mind and memory but weak in body, and calling to mind the uncertainty of Life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with do make and ordain this my last Will in manner following that is to say.

I desire that all my personal Estate be immediately sold after my decease, and all debts due my Estate to be Collected by my Executors to be hereinafter named, and out of the money arising therefrom, all my Just debts and funeral expenses be paid. and should the money arising therefrom prove Insufficient to satisfy the same. Then I direct and order my Executors to sell a sufficient quantity of my Land off of either side or line so as not to injure Value or situation of the house place wherein I now live, and to apply the moneys arising therefrom to the payment of the remainder of my Just debts as may be unpaid.

And after the payment of all my debts. I Give to my wife Polly all the remainder of my real Estate for the better enabling her to support and maintain her self and children to have and to hold untill my Oldest daughter Elizabeth Francis shall arrive at the full age of Twenty one years. provided she so long remains my widow and not otherwise.

And when my Oldest daughter E. F. shall arrive at full age I then order and direct that my executors sell all real as well as personal Estate and I then order my Executors to give and pay one third of the moneys arising from the sale of my personal as well as real Estate and to pay the same over to my wife Polly in full for her distributive share of my personal as well as real Estate

And further more I desire and direct my Executors not with standing the above If my wife Polly should deem it proper to marry and

me with do make and ordain this my last Will in mncor folowing that is to say.

I desire that all my personal Estate be imediatly sold after my decease, and all debts due my Estate to be Colected by my Executors to be hereinafter named, and out of the money arising therefrom, all my Just debts and funeral expenses be paid. and should the money arising therefrom prove Insufficient to satisefie the same. Then I direct and order my Executors to sell a sufficient quantity of my Land off of either side or line so as not to ainjure Value or cituation of the house place wherein I now live, and to apply the moneys arising therefrom to the payment of the remainder of my Just debts as may be un paid.

And after the payment of all my debts. I Give to my wife Polly all the remainder of my real Estate for the better enabling her to support and maintain her self and children to have and to hold untill my Ouldest daughter Elizabeth Francis shall arive at the full age of Twenty one years. provided she so long remains my widow and not otherwise.

And when my Ouldest daughter E. F. shall arive at full age I then order and direct that my executors sell all real as well personal Estate and I then give and order my Executors to pay one third of the moneys arrising from the sale of my personal as well as real Estate ad to pay the same over to my wife Polly in full for her distributive share of my personal as well as real Estate

And further more I desire and direct my Executors not with standing the above If my wife Polly should deem it proper to marry and cease to be my widow and marry a Second husband then and imediatly after such marrage I desire and order my Executors to proceed and sell all my personal as well as real estate and after deducting one third as aforesaid and paying the same over to my wife Polly

as aforesaid in full for her distributive share of my personal
as well as real estate

And all the remainder of my Estate both personal and real I give
and bequeath to my five Children to To Share and Share alike
namely Elizabeth Frances one moyety

John Philip one moyety

George Washington one moyety

David Thomas one moyety

Nancy Catherine Mandy one moyety

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my esteemed Brothers Mar-
tain & Michael Kinard Executors of this my last will and testa-
ment by me heretofore made. In testimony whereof I have hereunto
