HANNAH CROMER.

In the name of God Amen, I Hannah Cromer of the state of South Carolina and Newberry District being sick and weak of body, but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God, Calling unto mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament, that is to say.

First, my will and desire is that John Samuel Minger son of Daniel and Elisabeth Minger do have & freely possess my bed, bedstead, bed clothes & furniture, also my cow & calf & their increase & also my geese, & further, if the above mentioned John Samuel should die before he becomes of age, or makes use of the above mentioned property, then it is my will that my sister Elisabeth Minger do have and possess the above mentioned property, and after her death, it is my will that her bodily heirs possess the same.

2---- My will is that my sister Elisabeth Minger possess my Wheel, Cards, Saddle, Chest and Clothes during her natural life and after her death it is my will that her bodily heirs possess the same.

3---- I ratify and confirm this and no ~~less~~ other, to be my last will and testament, this twenty seventh day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, and in the sixtieth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
