

WILL OF
JACOB SHUMPERT.

The State of South Carolina

I Jacob Shumpert of the District of Newberry and state aforesaid being at this time in the enjoyment of the Ordinary powers of body & mind, do make and declare the following instrument of writing as & for my last Will & Testament, to wit:

First I give & bequeath to my wife Eleanor Shumpert all of the articles of personal property which she brought to my House on our marriage with the increase of such as may increase, together with one Hundred & forty four dollars & twenty seven cents (\$144.27 with Interest thereon from the date of this my will, until the Same be paid - I also give & bequeath to my said wife, the further sum of Five Hundred dollars (\$500) in cash to be paid to her twelve months from my death; also a sufficient sum for the decent maintainance of my said wife for one year shall be paid to her at my death----

Second - It being my intention to make the legacies herein after to be given to my sons equal among themselves, and those to my daughters equal among themselves, taking into consideration the advancements heretofore made to my said sons or daughters; now I hereby declare that I have advanced amounts in Cash or in property of that value to the following of my children, Vis;

I have laid off to my son Peter Shumpert a tract of Land which I have valued in the above list of advancements at one thousand dollars, but he being yet a minor I have not yet executed to him a title Deed for the same, now in the event of my death before I shall have executed to him such title Deed; then I

give & devise to the said Peter Shumpert the tract of Land which I have laid off for him, lying on the Beaver Dam Creek adjoining lands of W. D. Kelly & others

Third - It is my will & desire that all of my minor children be maintained ~~by~~ and educated out of my Estate until they respectively attain the age of twenty one years, or marry.

Fourth - It is my will & desire that the whole of my Estate both real & personal (except the land I have laid off to my son Peter) be sold by my Executors as soon after my death as may be deemed advisable, on a reasonable credit; and out of the proceeds of such sale I give & bequeath to each one of my daughters the sum of Seven Hundred dollars to be paid one year from the date of my death except my daughter Lucinda H. Shumpert to whom I give and bequeath out of the same fund the sum of Eight Hundred dollars to be paid at the same time

Fifth - I give & bequeath to my son John Jacob Shumpert the sum of Eleven Hundred dollars to be paid to him or his guardian twelve months from my death; and should I have any other son hereafter born to me, then I give & bequeath an equal sum to each of such sons, to be paid at the same time & in like manner.

Sixth - After the above clauses of my will have been carried into effect, and my sons equalized at Eleven Hundred dollars, and my daughters at Eight Hundred dollars; it is my will & desire that the whole rest & residue of my estate (except so much as may be necessary for the maintenance & education of my minor children as provided for in the third clause of this will) be equally divided between all my Children share & share alike

Seventh - It is my will & desire that the portions or shares which is to pass to my daughters Elizabeth Boyd wife of Kinard Boyd and Mary (Cannell) wife of Joseph G. Cannell under the fourth

Peter) be sold by my Executors as soon after my death as may be deemed advisable, on a reasonable credit; and out of the proceeds of such sale I give & bequeath to each one of my daughters the sum of Seven Hundred dollars to be paid one year from the date of my death except my daughter Lucinda H. Shumpert to whom I give and bequeath out of the same fund the sum of Eight Hundred dollars to be paid at the same time.

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Sixth - After the above clauses of my will have been carried into effect, and my sons equalized at Eleven Hundred dollars, and my daughters at Eight Hundred dollars; it is my will & desire that the whole rest & residue of my estate (except so much as may be necessary for the maintenance & education of my minor children as provided for in the third clause of this will) be equally divided between all my Children share & share alike.

Seventh - It is my will & desire that the portions or shares which is to pass to my daughters Elizabeth Boyd wife of Edward Boyd, and Mary Conwell wife of Joseph G. Conwell, under the fourth & sixth clauses of this will, be settled on the said Elizabeth B. Boyd & Mary Conwell by my Executors for their sole & separate use during their respective lives, and at their death, I give & bequeath the same to the heirs of their body respectively, absolutely & forever.

Eighth - The bequests in this will, to any child or children that may be hereafter born to me, is intended expressly to be

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for life only, and in case such child or children shall leave issue, the remainder is hereby given absolutely to such issue, but in case any such child should die with leaving issue then the bequest or share of such child under this will shall revert to my Estate & be divided among all my Children share & share alike

Ninth - I hereby nominate, constitute & appoint my sons George Adam, Samuel, John, Peter and John Jacob Shumpert Executors of this my last will and Testament

In witness whereof, I have hereto set my hand & seal this sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & forty two & Sixty fifth of the Independence of the U. S. of America
