my Plantation or Tract of land whereon I now live containing
one hundred and Seventy nine acres (more or less) also a negro
man Harry and woman Ann, and also all of my Personal Estate, and
what she may not wish to Keep it is my will that my Executors
hereafter named shall sell the same and Divide it Equally between
my wife Mary and Seven Children(viz)Nicholas, Sligh, Mary Bob,
John Sligh, Jacob Sligh, Andrew J. Sligh, Catharine Thompson, and
Sarah Bob, share and share alike also it is my will and Desire
(after the death of my wife) that if one or two of my Children
shall be willing to take the land, at a fair price or apprais-
ment by paying the other Legatees their part of the lands, and
if they cannot agree to assign it over to the one or two, It is
my will and Desire that it shall be sold by my Executors, as
also all of my personal Estate that, may be remaining at the
Death of my afo^r wife and Equally divided amongst my seven
Children above named

And lastly I do constitute my sons Jacob Sligh & Andrew J. Sligh
Executors of this my last will and Testament. In testimony where-
of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventeen-
th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hun-
dred & forty three
