 etion of my Executors herein after appointed Nothing Doubting but I shall Receive the same through the Mighty power of God & the Merits of my blessed Redeemer Jesus Christ at the Gener-
 al Refurrection of the Dead and Touching such Worldly Estate as it hath been please God to blefs me with in this Life I give and Devise in the following Manner and form Following -----
 IMPRIMIS I give and bequeath unto my Eldest Daughter Rachel Ford one Feather Bed and such Furniture as belongs to said it being the Bed she commonly sleeps on and no more out of my Estate -----
 Item and all the Rest of my Eftate to be Left and Bequeathed to my two Daughter Rebekah Anderson Widow and Elifabeth Lindsey the Wife of Samuel Lindsey to be Equally Divided between them only one Red haffer to be Left unto my Grandson John Ford son of James Ford (Decd ---- And my Old horse Commonly Called and Known by the Name of Shewmaker to my Dearly beloved Wife and at her Disposal Whome I Likewise make ordain Constitute and Appoint Rebekah Anderson Executrix and Samuel Lindsey my Execu-
 tors of this my Last Will and Testament and I do utterly Revoke all and Every former and other Will and Wills and Testaments made by me or in any before Named Willed and bequeathed Ratify-
 ing and Confirming this and nother to be my Last will and Tes-
 tament in Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
