

WILL OF
JAMES LINDSEY.

In the name of God Amen

I James Lindsey of Newberry District and State of South Carolina being weak in Body but of Sound mind Memory and of good understanding praise be to god for the Same do make this my last will & Testament in the manner & form following that is to say -----

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Caleb Williams Lindsey all my Real and personal Estate Consisting of all my lands where on I now live together with the following Negroes namely one Negro man Frank one Negro woman Alice & her three Children Mary oney & Liley and their Children mainly Suse Alice Tom delila & Sidney also one Negro woman Nina and her three Children Dick Sawney & George also one Negro man Ben Together with all my horses & Stock of Every Description my house hold & kitchen furniture Item, It is further my will & desire that my crop on hand should go toward the payment of my Just debts and should my Crop not ^{be} Suffecent to discharge all my Debts that my Executor hear after named Shall make such arrangements as he may think best so as not to Interfear or sell any of my Negro property above named. It is also my will that Incase my Son Should dye before he arrives to the age of Twenty one or gets married that all my property both Real & personal Should be Sold on this place where on I now live Except the old woman Alice which I wish her to be at Libberty and do as she wishes and in Case she becomes a Charge and is not able to support her self my Kxecutor must support her out of my Estate and all the monays arrising out of the Sale of my property or otherwise After all my Just Debts

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It is further my will and desire that Samuel Newton Davison the son of my Executor shall have five hundred Dollars Incase my son Should dye before he arrives to the age of Twenty one or gets married.

It is also my wish that my Executor Here after named Shall gave my old fellow frank Liberty to Chose his own Master and he to be taken at a moderate valuation.

Item, It is further my will that Incase my son Caleb Williams Lindsey Should dye leaving no living Children and Leaving a wife in such case it is my will that one half of my Estate Shold go to his wife and the other half as before mentioned.

It is also my will that my Executor Shall support out of my Estate my Brother Humphrey Lindsey during his natural life.

I do heareby nominate Constitute & appoint Samuel Davison Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all other and former wills and Testaments by me here to fore made In testimony where of I have here unto set my hand and Seal this August the ninth in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Eight Signed Sealed and Published and Declared as and for the last will and Testament of the above named James Lindsey. In the Presents of us.
