ner and form following that is to say--

First I give unt my son W^m Caldwell All that Tract of Land or
plantation Whereon I now Liv containing two hundred and twenty
six acres more or lefs one Bed and Bedstead two cows and the
Book Case

Secondly I give unto my daughter Mary P. Caldwell four hundred
dol ars two Cows one Bed and Sted and one Beaurough

Thirdly I give unto my Daughter Margaret Caldwell four hundred
dollars two Cows one Bed and sted and one ~~Beaurough~~ Sideboard

Fourthly I give unto My Daughter Jannet Wilson Three hundred dol-
lars

fiftyly It is my will and desire that all the rest residue and re-
mainder of My Estate Both real and personal and of what nature or
kind ~~Xxxx~~ soever Shall be sold by my executors herein after named
upon such credits as they may think propper and the proceeds to-
gether with the Money I may have on hand at the time of my death
my Bonds Notes Books of account and choses in action and so forth
After the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses -
