First I Give and Bequeath unto my Wife Lucinda Galloway all of the Land of which I am now possessed During her natural life or till my son John Galloway becomes Twenty one years of age I also will that when my son John Galloway becomes Twenty one years of age that he shall have the use of one hundred Acres of the land of which I ~~am~~ am now possessed till the Decease of my Wife Lucinda Galloway the remaining part of my land I Give and bequeath unto my Wife Lucinda Galloway During her natural life my Wife Lucinda Galloway is at this time Pregnant and should she be Delivered of a male child I will that at the decease of my Wife all the land of which I am now possessed be equally Divided in value between my two sons, should my Wife be Delivered of a Daughter I will that at the Decease of my Wife, that my son John Galloway have all the land of which I am now possessed I also will that all my personally property be sold and after paying all of my just Debts and Funeral expenses ---

I will that my Wife have one third part of my personal Estate. The remaining part of my personal Estate I will to be equally Divided among my five children namely Matilda Elizabeth John and Lucinda Galloway and one child of which my Wife is not yet Delivered Also I constitute and ordain Samuel Davison and Jesse Speer to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Witnes where of I set my hand and seal this ninth

of Life and being Desirous to Dispose of such Worldly Estate as it hath please God to blefs me with do make and Ordain this my last Will in manner following that is to say.

First I Give and Bequeath unto my Wife Lucind Galloway all of the Land of which I am now pofsefsed During her natural life or till my son John Galloway becomes Twenty one years of age I also will that when my son John Galloway becomes Twenty one years of age that he shall have the use of one hundred Acres of the land of which I ~~am~~ am now pofsefsed till the Decease of my Wife Lucinda Galloway the remaining part of my land I Give and bequeath unto my Wife Lucinda Galloway During her natural life my Wife Lucinda Galloway is at this time Pregnant and should she be Delivered of a male child I will that at the decease of my Wife all the land of which I am now pofsefsed be equally Divided in value between my two sons, should my Wife be Delivered of a Daughter I will that at the Decease of my Wife, that my son John Galloway have all the land of which I am now pofsefsed I also will that all my personally property be sold and after paying all of my just Debts and Funeral expences --

The remaining part of my personal Estate I will to be equally Divided among my five children namely Matilda Elisabeth John and Lucinda Galloway and one child of which my Wife is not yet Delivered Also I constitute and ordain Samuel Davison and Jefse Speer to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Witnefs where of I set my hand and seal this ninth day of December in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and forty
