fect mind and Memory Blessed be God this 20th, day of Septⁿ in
the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & Eighty four
do make and ordain this my Last Will In Manner and form fol-
lowing Vis

First of all I give unto my 3 sons James, John and William
Glen; all my Lands Containing 300 Acres, 200 Acres Whereon I
Now Live and 100 Acres that I bought of my Brother W^m Herbi-
son Deceased the same not Released as yet but promised by
Ann herbison his Widow that she will fulfil her husbands bar-
gains will release the said Land to me or to my heirs at any
time the said 300 Acres to be Equally Divided Between my 3
sons Before Named

Item, I give unto my son James Glen one Bay horse

Item, I give unto my son John Glen one Gray horse

Item, I give unto My Daughter Gean Glen Two Cows one a Yellow
and the Other a pided one & one Bay mair but the first Coult
that she hath shall belong to my Daughter Mary Glen

Item, I give unto my Daughter Margaret Glen 2 Cows a black one
and a white Backed one & a Black Mair but the first Coult
that she hath shall belong to my Daughter Ann Glen

Item I Give unto my Daughter Mary Glen 2 Heifers one Called
Spot the Other a Black One;

Item, I Give unto my Daughter Ann Glen 2 2 year old heifers
and after my Lawful Debts are all paid and my body Buried in
a Decent and Christian Like manner; Rest of my Goods and Chat-
ties Household Stuff and plantation Tools I Leave for use of
the plantation and to the Discretion of my Loving wife to be
Divided among my Children above Named at her Death but Nothing
above mentioned to be moved off of from the use of the planta-
tion Until such time as they are of full age and become
Masters of their Own Action & I also Constitute appoint and Ordain John
