JOHN HOLLOWAY

In the State of South Carolina

In the name of God Amen! I John Holloway of the District of Newberry and state aforesaid, being weak in body but of sound mind, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following.

First I wish my debts speedily paid.

Second. If Gen'e'l James J. Caldwell will recind the contract between him and my self for the purchase ~~for~~ of the mulatto woman ~~James~~ or Frankey and her children, I authorize my Executors to do so; and in that event, I authorize them to let him have my negro man Matt her husband at such price as may be fixed by three men to be chosen by him and my Execore.

Third If it be possible, as I hope it may I desire Lucy and her children Jim Sam and Eliza

three children to be kept, for my children Thomas and Helen.

Fourth I will order and direct that the rest of my estate real and personal be sold at such time and on such credit, as my Executors may think best and the proceeds after the payment of my debts together with all the rest and residue of my estate be equally divided between my two children Thomas and Helen.

Fifth I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friends John Howell and William H. Harrington Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other and former wills by me made and ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament

Third If it be pofable, as I hope it may I desire Lucy and her

three children to be kept, for my children Thomas and Helen.

Fourth I will order and direct that the rest of my estate real and personal be sold at such time and on such credit, as my Executors may think best and the proceeds after the payment of my debts together with all the rest and residue of my estate be equally divided between my two children Thomas and Helen.

Fifth I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friends John O' Neall and William H. Harrington Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other and former wills by me made and ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament
