JOHN MAYBIN.

I John Maybin of Columbia South Carolina Doe this day Make and publish this my last Will and testament as follows

- At
1-- I Gave to my beloved Wife Mary Maybin all the property or Money that has been or may be awarded hir from hir fathers Estate on a final Settlement of the Same to be hir own for Ever to gave use or Will to Whome Soever She pleses I also Gave to my wife my negro Girl ~~###~~ Hannah and hir Incesse during the Life of my Said Wife and at the death of my Wife the Said Negro and hir Incesse to Gee to my daughter Sally under the same Restrictions and Conditions as the Rest of my property Given hir under another Claus of this my Will I also give to my Wife all my Household and kitchen furniture Except one fether bed and Bed Stead and furniture which I Gave to my Daughter Sally I also Gave my Wife My Riding Hore and my Two Colts I also Gave my Wife my Lot of Land in the Town of Maybinton with the Improvements thare on untill my Daughter Sally Arives to the age of Eighteen or Marry at which time I direct that the said Lot with the Improvements thare on advert to my Said Daughter Sally under the Same restritation as the Rest of my Estate Given hir under a Later Claus of this my Will I also Direct that my Exr. hereafter appointed after my Just Debts ~~is~~ all paid and not before pay to my Wife for hir maintanance and Suprt Two Hundred Dollars pr. Anom out of the Interest arising from my Estate as Long as She Remains my Widow or untill my Daughter Sally arises to the age of Eighteen years or Marrys
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2-- I gave to my Son Benjamin My Tract of Land ~~Ednd~~ on the Phores River Containing about five Hundred Acres, but Should my unckel Jesse Maybin See Caus to take of the Said Tract of Land

Life of my Said Wife and at the death of my Wife the Said Negro and his Increase to Go to my daughter Sally under the same Restrictions and Conditions as the Rest of my property Given her under another Clause of this my Will I also give to my Wife all my Household and kitchen furniture Except one feather bed and Bed Stead and furniture which I Gave to my Daughter Sally I also Gave my Wife My Riding Hore and my Two Colts I also Gave my Wife my Lot of Land in the Town of Maybinton with the Improvements there on untill my Daughter Sally Arives to the age of Eighteen or Marry at which time I direct that the said Lot with the Improvements there on advert to my Said Daughter Sally under the Same restriction as the Rest of my Estate Given her under a Later Clause of this my Will I also Direct that my Exr. hereafter appointed after my Just Debts is all paid and not before pay to my Wife for her maintenance and Suprt Two Hundred Dollars pr. Anom out of the Interest arising from my Estate as Long as She Remains my Widow or untill my Daughter Sally arives to the age of Eighteen years or Marrye

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2-- I gave to my Son Benjamin My Tract of Land ~~Ednd~~ on the Enores River Containing about five Hundred Acres, but Should my unckel Jefse Maybin See Cause to take of the Said Tract of Land forty Nine Acres which Lyes South West of the present Maybin ferry Road to geather with a Right to one Half of the ferry or Bridg Landing. in that Case the Tract of Land So Willed Will ondley Contain about three Hundred and fifty Acres Lying North East of the Said Maybin ferry Road, the Rest of my Estate I Wish kept Togeather under the Directions of my Exr. thus paying my Just Debts first out of the Interest arriving from the Same untill My Daughter Sally arives to the age of Eightteen or Marrye at which time I direct that^d the ballance of my Estate then

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Remaining be divided betwixt my Two Children Sally and Benjamin
paying to Sally fifteen Hundred Dollars more then to Benjamin to
make his Share Equal With Benjamin for the Land Given to him
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3-- I will and direct that all the property Given my Daughter
Sally under the first Clause of this my Will and also all that
~~Money~~ May Come to her on a final Settlement of My Estate if in
Money I Direct that It be Laid out in Property and that property
So purchased to Gather with the other property above Mentioned.
I Gave to my Said Daughter and to the Heirs of his body for his
and then own Sole and Separate use and behafe for Ever
4 Should Either of My Said Children die before ariving at Lawfull
age then and in that Case I Will and direct that the Share of
my Estate Comming to the one Deceast Shall go to the Surviving
one and Should then both Die before ariving to Lawfull age or
Leving Issue then and in that Case I Will and Direct that the
Whole of My Estate So Given to my said Children be Equally
Divided betwix my father Benjamin Maybin and my Brother William
Maybin whome I Nominate and appoint my Executors to this My Last
Will and testament.
