I give unto my beloved wife Rachael the following property viz one negro man Prince one negro woman Milly waggon & two Horses two cows & calves four head of dry cattle sixteen head of Hogs, all such farming utensils as she may need, as much of the Household & Kitchen Furniture as she may select for her own use and also as much of the crop as she may wish to have and to hold during her life and at her death to be sold by my Executor here in after appointed and divided as I direct in a future provision of this my last will & Testament

I will that all my property of every kind what so ever not enumerated and willed by the above bequests, to my son George and my wife, be sold after my death. the proceeds of which, ~~together with the~~ I here by give to the children of my deceased daughter Mary Monts, of my deceased daughter Saley ble of my deceased daughter Sussey Shepperd. (these children to take the shares their respective mothers would have been entitled to had they been alive) and to my daughter Eve Koon wife of

I here by constitute my Son George Feagle my Executor of this my last will and Testament.
