In the name of God Amen I Lucy Buchanan a free person of Colour do make & ordain this my last will and testament First I will all my debts to be punctually paid out of such perishable property as I may die possessed of

Second the remainder of my estate both real and personal including my son William who is a Slave, I will & devise to my friend Lemuel Glymph until his youngest son Josephus Glymph arises at the age of twenty one years, and after that time to the said Josephus Glymph his heirs and assigns for ever. I devise my son William to Lemuel Glymph and his son Josephus believing and trusting that they will treat him humanly and kindly & leave him in their hands with confidence as being the best disposition that according to the laws of this State I can make for his welfare.

I also appoint my friend Lemuel Glymph my sole Executor of this my last will and testament in witness where of I have hereth unto set my hand & Seal this May 9-- 1831
