Alsa to my son Moch Baltz live one bay Harse and a note which I hold againa him my said son Roah Enlow for the Sum of Fifty Three Dollars and sixty. three cents bearing Date the Fifteenth Day of August 1845 if the said note is not paid before my Death. Also to my Daughter Polly Enlow one Bead Sted Bed and Furniture and a note for the sum three Dollars and Twenty Five cents bearing date the ifteenth Day of august 1845 .. Also to my youngest Daughter Mary .. M. Enlow I give my bead and Furniture and Bed Sted and one note for the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty cents Bearing date the 15" day of August 1845. Also to my Doaughter polly Enlow one Calf. a Hiefer Also to my youngest Deaughter Hary, A. M. Enlow one cov. nd to my Deaughter Elizabeth Enlow and my son Moah Enlow I give and bequeath the Remainder of my Stock of com. Also to my three Deaughters Elizabeth Enlow Folly Enlow & Mary A. H. Enlow & my son Noah Enlow I give and bequeath all my land forever to them and their leave to have and to hold the said lands and tenements Committee long as they ever together, but if either one should mary or become Dissatisfied the maried have their part out off and setle on it but Should they not agree to live together the Land Shall be Hented and the profits thence arising shall be Equall my eldest sea william amlow I Cave one Sow and pigs, one Hiefer Two Dollars and one not for rent amounting to Twenty Dollars, the soy & pies. Hiefer and Two Dollars he has already got. Alegate my son Boch Balant Site one bay Harse and a note which I hold agains him my eaid son Hoah Enlow for the Sum of Fifty Three Dollars and sixty three cents bearing Date the Fifteenth Day of August 1845 if the said note is not paid before my Death. Also to my Daughter Polly Enlow one Bead Sted Bed and Furniture and a note for the sum three Dollars and Twenty Five cents bearing date the ifteenth Day of august 1845.. Also to my youngest Daughter Mary ... M. Enlow I give my bead and Furniture and Bed Sted and one note for the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty cents Bearing date the 15 day of August 1845. Also to my Doaughter polly Enlow one Calf. a Hiefer Also to my youngest Deaughter Mary, A. M. Enlow one cow, nd to my Deaughter Elizabeth Enlow and my son Noah Enlow I give and bequeath the Remainder of my Stock of cows, Also to my three Deaughters Klizabeth Enlow Polly Enlow & Mary A. M. Enlow & my son Moah Enlow I give and bequeath all my land forever to them and their leaus to have and to hold the said lands and tenements come of long as they can together, but if either one should mary or become Dissetisfied the maried / have their part out off and setle on it but Should they not agree to live together the Land Shall be Rented and the profite thence arising shall be Equall Divided emongst them, and my con William Enlow Shall also have an equal part of the Rent with the other children Should the premises aforementioned be Rented out to other persons but so long as my said children Shall continue to live together on the said premises he Shall not Exact any Rent from them or any one of them.

And Lestly. I do will and direct that all debts due me at my Doath Shall be collected by my som noch Enlow hom I hereby

appoint sole Executor of this my last will and testement, and my Debts and Funeral charges paid out of the same and should there not be Honey enough coming to me to pay all the Debts due by me at my Death My said Executor shall colect Equaly off the Legatees with himself to pay the said Debts.
