girl Vina to gether with their future increase

Fourthly I give unto my Daughter Rebecca Boazman one Girl
hannah and one boy will, together with her future increase and
also Harriet I give unto my daughter Rebecca Boazman

Fifthly I give unto my Grandson Thomas D. Boazman one girl
Bethana to gether with her future increase.

Sixthly, I give also unto my Son Tho. A Rudd one Boy Anthony,
and one woman Gin one Boy Isaac But it is my will and desire
that he shall account to my Estate any thing for the two last
named negress Gin and Isaac.

Seventhly I give also unto my daughter Susan Rudd Ellen and her
two youngest children to gether with their future increase.

Eighthly I give unto my son Pery Rudd Pompey and Hamp and the
best bed and furniture that I have the bed to be over and above
his parts.

Ninthly I give unto my son John Rudd Two hundred dollars more
than than his equal part

than her equal part

Sixthly, I give also unto my Son Tho. A Rudd one Boy Anthony, and one woman Gin one Boy Isaac But it is my will and desire that he shall account to my Estate any thing for the two last named negress Gin and Isaac.

will and Testament This the Tenth day of June in the year of
our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty one
