of Body but of sound Disposing mind and Memory do Ordain and
Constitute this my Last Will and Testament Revoking all other
Wills whatsoever -----
Imprimis My Will is that my Wife Mary Harris do enjoy my whole
Estate both Real and Personal During her Natural Life and after
her Decease to be Divided as followeth -----
Item --my Desire is that my two young Negros Jack & Cloe be
Disposed of as followeth my Negror boy Jack I give to my Son
Moseby and his heirs forever - and my Negro Girl Cloe to my
Daughter Rebecca and her heirs forever, my will is that a
slipe of Land Crofing Mill Creek Joining Caldwell Turner, Boun-
ty and myself Containing about forty Acres Cald the Mill seat
to be sold by my Executors hereafter Named towards paying my
Debts and Soforth, as for my son Richard being absent and not
Returned if in case he should Return in Person my Will is that
there Should be some Acknowledgment made and if not it is a
Dead Leagaoy Viz that is to say that Several Legatees hereaf-
ter Named do pay their parpotions to the amount of Twenty
pounds in the whole which Twenty pounds I would that he Receive
in person else not at all after the Decease of my Wife, my Will
is that my Children do enjoy Viz that is to say the Whole Es-
tate Real and Personal excepting heretefore excepted to be e-
qually Divided between them four Children Jamima Samuel Little
Berg Clough. My Will is that if either of thes two young Negros
should Die Jack and Cloe or prove otherways then healthy at the
Division of my Estate that my son Moseby and Daughter Rebecca
do have liborty to throw up their legasys into the Estate and
have their proportione with the other Children --- my desire is
that there be fifty Shillings paid to my Grandson David Gillam
out of my Estate as Witnefs my hand and seal this Thirtieth day
of December in the year of our Lord 1787.
