In the Name of God Amen. I Peter Dewalt being weak of body
but of sound mind and Memory do this Twenty first day of Febru-
ary in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Eigh-
ty Nine make and Publish this my last Will and Testament in Man-
ner and form following that is to say I Give my Soul into the
hands of my Maker a most merciful in hope of a Glorious Resurrec-
tion, & my body to be Decently buried at the Discretion of my
Executors

First I Give my Brotherin-Law George Gray One hundred Acres of
Land that is Willed to me by my Father likewise my my Clothen--
Secondly I also give and bequeath to my Mother and four Sisters
Namely Mary and Catharina & Susana & Ruth all the Remainder of my
Lands & other propety to be Equilly Divided - I make my loving
friends George Gray and James Boyle Overseers & Executors of this
my last Will and Testament to see it faithfully Performed I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal the day & Year first Above Written,
Signed Sealed & Delivered as
my last Will & Testament in
