In the Name of God Amen I Peter Galloway of the District of  
Ninety six Being weak of Body but of perfect mind and Memory  
Blessed be God this Twenty sixth day of October Anno: Dom: 1774  
do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in manner  
following that is to say ----- First of all I give and  
Bequeath unto my Loving Wife Margret Galloway the House and  
Plantation where on I now Live Containing one Hundred Acres,  
During her Natural Life and after her Decease the same to belong  
unto my son Peter Galloway, also I give unto my son James  
Galloway the full sum of five pounds to be paid out of the  
whole of my Estate If the same shall be Lawfully Demanded, also,  
I give unto my son John Galloway One Hundred acres of Land  
Originally Granted to George Hayworth and Fifty Acres Joyning  
it being the Remainder of the Tract of Land whereon I now  
Live, Also I give unto my son Peter Galloway Fifty Acres of  
Land it being the Remainder of of a Tract of one hundred fifty  
Acres Originally Granted to George Haworth, the other part I  
have Given unto my son John Galloway, also I give unto my  
Daughters Mary Douglas, Elizabeth Galloway, Gean Galloway,  
Annas Galloway, and Martha Galloway, all that Plantation or  
Tract of Land Containing Two hundred Acres Surveyed for  
James Brooke, to be Equally Divided amongst them. Two hundred  
Acres Surveyed for James Brooke, to be Equally D  
Likewise it is my Will and Desires that they should all Live  
Together till they Eat this years Crop that is now made, also  
it is my Desires that my son in law John Douglass should Tend  
the field Down the Creek for three or four years till he Can  
Get himself Setted, also I Give unto my son John Galloway One  
Gray mare to be his proper Right but Not to be moved off the  
plantation, till he is of full age, Also I give unto my son

unto my son John Galloway my Silver Watch, a Saddle a hand saw  
and a smooth Bone Musket Gun, also, I give unto my Son peter

Galloway one Saddle one hand saw and a smooth Bore Gun, The  
Remainder of my Goods and Chatties I Leave to the Use of the  
plantation, and to the Discretion of my Loving wife To be  
Devided at her pleasure at her Death among my Children before  
Mentioned also I Constitute and Ordain William herbison and  
Robert speer to be the Exasseters of this my Last Will and  
Testament in witness whereof I set my hand and Seal the day and  
Year above written
