PETER GRAY

The State of South Carolina

I Peter Gray of the District of Newberry and State aforesaid do make & declare the following for & as my last Will & Testaments: viz -

First-- Having by a Deed dated on the 23rd day of August 1831 conveyed to my nephew Henry Gallman all of my negroes of which I may die possessed or entitled to, as will appear from said deed in the possession of the said Henry Gallman, I hereby confirm the said deed & my Will is that it take effect at my death & it is hereby made a part & clause of this My Will.

Secondly-- I desire that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as practicable --

Third-- My will is that all the rest & residue of my Estate both real & personal (including cash on hand, chases in action &c) with the exception of the property contained in the deed to Henry Gallman named in the first clause of this will & also except so much as may be necessary to discharge the debts due me at my death & my funeral expenses, be sold by my Executors hereinafter to be named upon the most advantageous terms, and the proceeds thereof where collected to be paid over to Dr. George W. Glenn, Gury Booser Esq. & Isaac Keller Esq. upon the trust to be expressed in the next clause of this my will.

Fourth-- I hereby constitute and appoint the said ~~of~~ George W. Glenn, George Booser Esquire and Isaac Keller Esquire and their ~~successors~~ to be appointed by the Court of Equity for said District, trustees for the following purposes, viz- first to receive from my Executors the amount directed in the 3rd clause of this will to be paid to them by my Executors, and to invest the same

I may die possessed or entitled to, as will appear from said deed in the possession of the said Henry Callman, I hereby confirm the said deed & my Will is that it take effect at my death & it is hereby made a part & clause of this My Will.

Secondly-- I desire that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as practicable --

Third-- My will is that all the rest & residue of my Estate both real & personal (including cash on hand, chases in action &c) with the exception of the property contained in the deed to Henry Callman named in the first clause of this will & also except so much as may be necessary to discharge the debts due me at my death & my funeral expenses, be sold by my Executors hereinafter to be named upon the most advantageous terms, and the proceeds thereof where collected to be paid over to Dr. George W. Glenn, Gury Boozier Esq^r & Isaac Keller Esq^r upon the trust to be expressed in the next clause of this my will.

Fourth-- I hereby constitute and appoint the said Dr George W. Glenn, George Boozier Esquire and Isaac Keller Esquire and their ~~successors~~ to be appointed by the Court of Equity for said District, trustees for the following purposes, viz- first to receive from my Executors the amount directed in the 3rd clause of this will to be paid to them by my Executors, and to invest the same from time to time, safely, in the best permanent stocks or securities, public or private, at their discretion; Secondly to employ so much of the income thereof as may be necessary, and no more towards supplying any deficiency that may at any time exist towards the support of the preaching of the Gospel in the Presbyterian Church of Avelleigh, & toward the necessary repaire of the buildings & enclosures of said church, and annually to ^{invest} receive from time to time, so much of said income as may not be necessary for

quired for the aforesaid purposes; so as to form an accumula-
ting fund for said church so long as it may continue to be a
Congregation; the income of said reinvestments of income to be
applicable to the same purposes as the original income.
Fifth-- I hereby nominate & appoint Henry Gallman, Drayton-
Mance & F. B. Higgins Executors of this my last will & testament-
signed, sealed published &
declared by the said Peter
Gray as & for his last will
& testament in our presence,
who in his presence at his re-
quest & in the presence of
each other have witnessed the
due execution thereof The same
having been read to him on ac-
count of his blindness before
the Execution thereof by him
