give Elizabeth Kempson Daughter of said Harmon Thirty Dollars---

I give Benjamin Kempson son of S<sup>d</sup> Harmon Thirty Dollars--- I

give Henry Kempson son of s<sup>d</sup> Harmon Thirty Dollars--- I give

Susannah Kempson Daughter of s<sup>d</sup> Harmon Thirty Dollars, all the

above sums or legacies to be raised out of the personal property

that I may be seized and possessed of at the time of my decease

and it is my will and Desire that all the remainder of my Personal

Estate that may remain after raising the above sums or legacies, of

whatsoever kind, Shall belong to Frederick Kempson and I do give

and bequeath the same to him the said Frederick Kempson and his

heirs forever and lastly I do constitute and appoint my Friends

Frederick Kempson and Peter Kempson Executors of this my last

I give Benjamin Kempeon son of S<sup>d</sup> Harmon Thirty Dollars--- I give Henry Kempson son of S<sup>d</sup> Harmon Thirty Dollars--- I give Susannah Kempson Daughter of S<sup>d</sup> Harmon Thirty Dollars, all the above sum or legacies to be raised out of the personal property that I may be seized and possessed of at the time of my decease and it is my will and Desire that all the remainder of my Personal Estate that may remain after raising the above sum or legacies, of whatsoever Kind, Shall belong to Frederick Kempson and I do give and bequeath the same to him the said Frederick Kempson and his heires forever and lastly I do Constitute and appoint my Friends Frederick Kempson and Peter Kempson Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all other and former wills and Testaments by me heretofore made, - In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twenty fifth Day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred & Twenty five and in the Forty ninth year of the Independence of

the United States of America.
