Will and Testament

at
Clause 1-- It is my will and desire that my Wife Jane Lyles
shall have my plantation containing four hundred acres of land
more or less on which I now reside during her natural life time
or widow hood also Five negroes viz George, Nat, Hannah, Chaney
Bernathy and Chaney Connerly. Also my Burch and harness with
two horses or mules as she may choose and Waggon and Waggon
harness, also Two Beds Bedsteads & bed Furniture and her Bedrow.

Also one hundred bushels of corn and one Thousand pounds of pork

Clause 2.. I Give to my Son Thomas W Lyles my negro man Bob
(Crimes) also there is a debt of one Thousand Dollars with
Interest on the same at this time owing to col. John Glenn of
this District by my Son T..Lyles which I will to be paid out of
proceeds of my general Estate for which he is not to account for
to rest of my children unless he choose so to doo of his own
free will. I give to my son Jefsey W.Lyles my negro man (tittle)
Bob. To my Son John M.Lyles my negro man Burrell. To my Son
William L.Lyles my two negro boys Aaron and Morgan. To my
daughter Sarah A.Lyles my negro girl Francis and negro boy Wesley
to have and to hold unto my Daughter S.A.Lyles and her Bodily
heirs for ever also one Bed Bedstead and Bed furniture. To my
Daughter Eliza A. Boatner my negro Girl Luiza to have and to hold
unto my said Daughter P.A. Boatner and her bodily heirs for ever

Clause 3.. I further will the negroes as above named that I have
given to my children be appraised by suitable and sworn appraisers
and that each child receive them at there respective valuations
and account to each other according to valuation

Clause 3.. I further will the negroes as above named that I have

given to my children be appraised by suitable and sworn appraisers

and that each child receive them at there respective valuations

and account to each other according to valuation

Clause 4.. It is my will that the negroes left to my Son William

and Daughter Sarah shal remand on the plantation with my Wife

during her life time or widow hood or until they or either of them

may become of age or marry and for said negroes to labour for my

life free of hier and that my said children William & Sarah

remain on said plantation as above stated free of charge for

board

Clause 5.. I will that my Son William & Daughter Sarah have a

good English education given them at the expense of my general
estate

th
Clause 6.. I further will that all my personal property not
leave to fore named except Four negroes viz Reuben, Joe, Henry
and Isaac shall be sold at public auction at a suitable time
and as soon after my death as the crop that may be on the plan-
tation can be gathered and on such terms and credits as my
Executors may think best and if the proceeds of the same should
be insufficient to pay all the Just demands against my Estate I
will that as many of the Four negroes as above named and except-
ed; be sold as may be sufficient for the same but if the sale
of the afore said and above named Four negroes together with
such other of my personal property as I have above directed to
be sold should prove to be insufficient to pay all Just demands
against my Estate it is my will that all the Negroes that I have
willed to my children and Wife remain on the plantation and my
farm carried on until my debts are paid together with such other
provisions etc as my Executors may think proper for the same

Clause 7.. I will that at the death or Marriage of my Wife
that my Executors take immediate charge of the property left to
my wife both real and personal and ~~and~~ and sell the same as
soon as the crop that may be on hand can be gathered on such
conditions and credits as they may think fit and proper and as
soon as they can conveniently make a settlement on my Estate they
shall make an equal distribution of the proceeds of the same
among my Lawful Heirs

Clause 8.. I will that my Family Grave yard be paved in in a
good and substantial manner at the expense of my general Estate

th
Clause 9.. I appoint my Sons Jasey W. Lyles and ~~and~~ my
Thomas W. Lyles

Executors may think best and if the proceeds of the same should be insufficient to pay all the Just demands against my Estate I will that as many of the Four negroes as above named and excepted; be sold as may be sufficient for the same but if the sale of the afore said and above named Four negroes together with such other of my personal property as I have above directed to be sold should prove to be insufficient to pay all Just demands against my Estate it is my will that all the Negroes that I have willed to my children and Wife remain on the plantation and my Farm carried on until my debts are paid together with such other provisions etc as my Executors may think proper for the same

Clause 7.. I will that at the death or Marriage of my Wife that my Executors take immediate charge of the property left to my wife both real and personal and ~~and~~ and sell the same as soon as the crop that may be on hand can be gathered on such conditions and credits as they may think fit and proper and as soon as they can conveniently make a settlement on my Estate they shall make an equal distribution of the proceeds of the same among my Lawful Heirs

Clause 8.. I will that my Family Grave yard be paved in in a good and substantial manner at the expence of my general Estate

Clause 9.. I appoint my Sons Jefacy W. Lyles and ~~and~~ Thomas W. Lyles my duly qualified Executors with full power and authority to carry out my will and wishes as above expressed in this my last will and testament Given under my hand and seal in the presents of the subscribing witnesses the sixth day of February Eighteen hundred and Forty six and in the seventyeth year of the Sovereignty and Independance of the United States of America
