In The Name of God Amen, I Robert Man

Ninety Six District of the Province & District aforesaid Being sick of Body but in sound and Perfect Memory do Give and Dispose of my Temporal Estate as Followeth; That is to say, I give and Bequeath unto my Loving Wife Susanna Man all my Movable Estate During her Life Except one Mare Coult, Also my Plantation to my Wife During her Life without Interruption; my Movable Estate to be to my Wifes Desposial at her Decease; I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving Son James Man One Hundred Acres of Land Joyning the Far Spring; I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving son John Man One Hundred Acres of Land Joining to his Brother James Man and Bequeath unto my son Robert Man One Hundred of Land Where my Plantation is; I also Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Manfse Man Fifty Acres of Land Opposite before the Door Next Joseph Greenes; NB. My son Robert Mans Land to be Laid out Square with the Plantation; also one Mare Coult If any of my sons should not think Fit to Settle on the said Lands they are not to sell it to a Stranger But his Brothers to have it by Making him Lawful Restitutions; I Give unto my son James Man & John Man & Robert Man & Manafsch Man & Jean Nix & Susannah Man Two Hundred Pounds Curr^t in the Hands of Thomas M^cGrady to be Equally Divided if the Monay can be Got; I also Constitute and Appoint my Loving Wife Susannah Man & my Loving son James Man to be my Lawful Executors to act in my Behalf in all Cases after my Decease I further Declare this to be my Last Will & Testament. In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27th, Day of March 1788.
