I Sarah Bundrick do make and
declare this to be my last will

and testament.

First. I will and devise to my three children, Polly Bundrick, George David Bundrick and William Frank Bundrick the plantation or tract of land where on I now live containing twenty five acres more or less, bounded by lands of David Hints, of the estate of George Higlebergers of Nicholas Kinard and George Kinard to them and their heirs for ever, Also one Horse and one cow and calf.

Second. I will and bequeath to my two Sons George David Bundrick and William Frank Bundrick so long as they both live and after the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, my negro boy, called Silas.

Third I will and bequeath to my daughter Polly Bundrick one bed and bedstead.

Fourth The remainder of my estate I will to be sold on such terms as my executors may think best and avails of such sales to gether with my debts owing to me at my death I direct to be applied first to the payment of my just debts, then to pay to my son Abner Bundrick the sum of Two hundred dollars and the balance of any I direct to be equally divided among my four children above mentioned
