said, One Third part of my Movable Estate after all my Just
Debts are paid and the Remainder part to my Loving son James
Lewis, & it is further my Will that my Sons pr^t be sold and
the Money to be put out ~~at interest~~ ^I until he ~~be 21~~ ^{be 21} of Age. I
so Constitute & Appoint my Loving Friends Michail Sandrifs &
George Goggans to be my Lawful Executors to Act for me After
my Decease in all Things According to Law This being my Last
Will and Testament, Ratifying this & no other In Witnefs
