THOMAS BAUMKETT.

State of South Carolina

Newberry District

I Thomas Baumkett of the District and State aforesaid being weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in the following form and manner, Viz.

Item 1st My will and desire is that all my just debts be first paid out of my estate

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Wadlington all the Lands that I now possess be the same more or less to her during her lifetime or widowhood and at her death or marriage the said lands to be equally divided between her two children Thomas B. Wadlington and Caroline I. Wadlington.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Wadlington Seven Negroes Viz Squire, Orange, Hiram, Eve, Sina, Amelia, and Green with their future increase during her lifetime or widowhood and at her death or marriage the aforesaid negroes with their increase to be equally divided between her two children Thomas B. Wadlington and Caroline I. Wadlington

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my son John Baumkett Eighteen negroes Viz. Charles, Sam, Cyrus, George, Billy, Silas, Spencer, Caty, Cloe, Meriah, Susie, Joe Lucy ~~and~~ Henry David, Hulda, Nathan and Andrew with their future increase to him and his heirs

Item 5th I will and desire that all my wearing apparel except my watch be equally divided between my Five negro men Viz Charles, Sam Cyrus George and Squire,

Item 6th I will and desire that all the balance of my property that I may be possessed of at the time of my death be sold,

first paid out of my estate

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Wadlington all the Lands that I now possess be the same more or less to her during her lifetime and at her death or marriage the said lands to be equally divided between her two children Thomas B. Wadlington and Caroline I. Wadlington.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Wadlington Seven Negroe Viz Squire, Orange, Hiram, Eve, Sina, Amelia, and Green with their future increase during her lifetime or widowhood and at her death or marriage the aforesaid negroes with their increase to be equally divided between her two children Thomas B. Wadlington and Caroline I. Wadlington

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my son John Baughett Eighteen negroes Viz. Charles, Sam, Cyrus, George, Billy, Silas, Spender, Caty, Cloe, Meriah, Susa, Joe Lucy ~~and~~ Henry David, Hulah Nathan and Andrew with their future increase to him and his heirs

Item 5th I will and desire that all my wearing apparel except my watch be equally divided between my Five negro men Viz Charles, Sam Cyrus George and Squire,

Item 6th I will and desire that all the balance of my property that I may be possessed of at the time of my death be Sold, and the monies arising from said sale be equally divided between my two Children Nancy Wadlington and John Baughett

Item 7th And lastly I do nominate and appoint Nancy Wadlington Executrix and John Baughett Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Will or Wills by me made I do declare this to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty
