after Hamed. Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I

Shall Receive the Same again by the mighty power of God - and

as Touching such worldly Goods or Estate, where with it hath

pleased God to blefs me with in this life -- I Give Demise and

Dispose of the Same in the manner and form following (viz) -----

Item I Give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son Edward Turner.

One Negroe Girl named Amy and Two Hundred Dollars and One

Feather Bed and no more to him and his heirs for ever -----

Item I Give and Bequeath to My Beloved Daughter Mary Edwards

One Negroe Man named Cocco and one Negroe Girl named Jinney

which Said Girl is now in her possession the Same to her and her

heirs for ever -----

Item I Give and bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Elizabeth

Stephens One Negroe Woman named Siller and One Negroe Girl named

Book which Said Girl is now in her possession - to her and her

heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Deborah Cook -

One negroe woman named Sharlot and her Child AGGY. which Said

Negroe Woman and Child I Delivered them to her Some years ago,

her and her Said Child to her and her heirs ~~for ever~~ for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Well beloved daughter Priscilla

Long wife of Major Benjamin Long and her Children Lawfully

be gotten of her Body by the Said Benjamin Long Three negroes,

to wit, Monday a negroe man and Sibb his wife & their Son

Jacob a Small boy them and their Increase unto the Said Priscilla

Long & her Said Children from this hence forward for ever -----

but if the Said Pricilla Long Should think proper at any time after my Decease to Relinquish hir Claim of in or to the Negroes above mentioned, unto to hir said Children above mentioned that she have full power so to do at any time She shall think proper and hir Relinquishment so given shall be full authority for my Executors here after named to diliver the said negroes to the said Children above mentioned -----

Item I Give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Daughter in Law Fanny Turner wife of my Son John Turner Dec. and to his Heirs Lawfully begotten of hir body. Excepting Polly Peterson wife of David Peterson which I have left a negro boy here after named, One negro Girl named Pegg to them and their heirs for ever----- and no more for ever -----

Item I Give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Polly Peterson above mentioned one negro Boy named Charles which she has now in hir possesion, to hir and hir ~~his~~ heirs for ever -----

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter in law Mary Mitchell formerly the wife of William Turner My Son Deceased, & hir five Children heirs of the Said William Turner Dec. the Sum of One Dollar & fifty Cents to be Equally Divided amongst them and no more ----- to them forever -----

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter in law Mary Barreth formerly wife of my son Richard Turner Deceased and to her Two Children heirs of the Said Richard Turner Deceased the Sum of One Dollar & fifty Cents and no more to them and their heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto the heirs of My Son in law Michael Abney Deceased To wit Nathaniel Abney James Abney, William Abney & Anny Buffington the Sum of One Dollar and fifty Cents to be Equally Divided amongst them and no more forever -----

Item It is my will and Desire that all my Just Depts and funeral Charges be Justly & timely paid out of the Remainder of my Estate by my Executors here after named and it is my will and Desire that the Balance of my Personal Estate be sold at Publick Sale, and the money arising from the sale of the Said property Consisting of Horses, Cattle, Hogm Plantation Tools House hold & kitchen furniture etc Together with Two Small negroes Children named Prince & Sarah, and after payment of my Just Debts &

funeral Charges and the Legacy of Two Hundred Dollars left to Edward Turner above mentioned it is my will and Desire that the Ballance be Equally Divided betwixt my four Daughters namely Molly Edward Elizabeth Stephens Deborah Cook and Pricilla Long Share and Share alike and Also it is my will and Desire that that my Executors here after named are here by Empowered and Authorised to Sell a Certain Tract of Land Lying and being in the District of Newberry aforesaid and the money arising from the Sale of the said land is Also to be Equally Divided amongst my four Daughters above mentioned the sale of the ^{said} Land to be discretionary with my Executors, and the titles made to the purchaser or purchasers of the said Land ~~by~~ by Either of my Executors is to be good and known in law as my Own Act and Deed, the Said Land Joins Lands of Frances Wiggins James Glen Benjamin Long & Henry Coate & Jacob Crofawhite -----

Lastly and finally I do here by nominate Constitute and appoint my Beloved Son in Law Benjamin Long and Henry Coate to be my Executors to this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoke and Disannul all and Every Other former Testaments wills Legacies Bequests & Executors by me in any wise before made, Willed Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no Other to be my last will and Testament in Witnefs where of I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal this

Nineteenth Day of July in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eleven and in the thirty Sixth year of American Independence ----- Signed Sealed published and Declared by the said Elizabeth Turner as hir last will and Testament in the presence of us who in hir presence and in the presence of each Other Subscribed our names as witnesses there to

that I Elizabeth Turner of the State and



I the Said Elizabeth Turner by this present Codicil do Ratify and Confirm my Said Last Will and Testament-- and Do further Give and bequeath unto my well beloved Grandson Benjamin Franklin Long the One half of a Tract of Land Lying and being in the District of Newberry and State of South Carolina aforesaid on a Small Branch Commonly Cald Rockey Branch waters of Salludy River beginning at a stake 3 plus n.m. thence S. 35 West 15-70 to Stake 3 plus o.m. thence S. 56 East 47. to a Walnut 3plus o.m. thence N.35 E.15 Chains to a Stake Corner which is the Division Corner between this present half of Said Tract and the Other half which I have Sold to Henry Coate - thence along a Division Line as Laid Off to said Henry Coate the Said Division Line as Run or Laid Down to him is to be known as the Dividing Line of Said Tract between the Said Henry Coate and Benjnun F Long the Said Land being part of a Tract of Land originally Granted to John Attenger the Said Original Grant Contained one Hundred acres & the Said Benjn F Longs part, to Contain fifty acres be the Same more or less as the same is laid down to him agreeable to the Courses, Lines and Corners as above mentioned Said Land being the South Side of the Original Survey Joins Frances Higgins & Henry Coate ---- Also It is my will that the said Benjamin F. Long Shall pay to his three Aunts Namely Mary Edward Elizabeth Stephens & Deborah Coate with in the Term of Three ^{Decesse} years from my ~~the sum of Twenty Dollars Each. Also I Give and~~ bequeath unto the Said Benjamin F. Long one Sorrel mare & Colt the said Land Mare & Colt to him and his heirs for ever and I Do here by Revoke So much of my Last Will and Testament above mentioned as Relates Toward the Selling of my Land by my Executors and I do here by revoke so much of Said Will as Respects the Said Lands or the price or value there of in any way whatever - And my will and meaning is that this Codicil be adjudged to be a part and parcel of my Last Will and Testament and that all things therein mentioned and Contained be faithfully and fully performed and as fully and amply in Every Respect as if the Same were so Declared and Set Down in my Said Last Will & Testament witness my hand and Seal this Twenty Second Day of December Anodomin 1812
